Pronounced Mam ma we, (ᐃᐃᐃᐃ when written in Cree Slavic’s), it reflects Syncrude’s commitment to inclusion in the way we work and the importance in honouring and respecting the Treaty 8 territory and homeland of the Métis people. Along with honouring all of the First Nation, Métis and Inuit peoples who have lived, traveled and gathered on these lands, nothing is more important to our success than making sure we all go home safely at the end of each day. We value the safety of our work force above all else and believe that the only acceptable way to complete this planned maintenance event is to ensure that nobody gets hurt. To that end, I ask you to join the other members of our team in personally committing to making safety the first consideration in everything you do while working on Project Mâwawi.

I sincerely wish you a safe event and thank you for joining the Mâwawi team, All Together, “One Team, One Goal, One Result!”

SECURITY EXPECTATIONS

Syncrude is committed to the safety and security of its employees and contractors. In recognition of this commitment, the following SECURITY EXPECTATIONS have been deemed fundamentally important in the deterrence of prohibited activity.

1 Your SYNCRUDE ID CARD must be worn and visible at all times while on site.

2 You must present your SYNCRUDE ID CARD at all times when requested.

3 Your assigned SYNCRUDE ID CARD is for your authorized personal use only.

Do not use your ID card to scan anyone else on site.

4 ANY and ALL activity associated with your SYNCRUDE ID CARD is YOUR responsibility. If your card is lost, it is YOUR responsibility to report it to Security immediately.

5 Syncrude has a ZERO TOLERANCE for violence in the workplace including but not limited to verbal abuse, interpersonal violence and harassment.

6 You are not permitted to be in possession or under the influence of alcohol while accessing or working on any Syncrude site.

7 You are not to be under the influence of any illegal drugs, or in possession of drugs or drug paraphernalia while accessing or working on the Syncrude site. This includes provided lodging.

8 Possession of firearms, ammunition or other prohibited weapons on any Syncrude site is forbidden.

9 Video monitoring is in operation at each point of site entry and egress; Syncrude collects and may reasonably use and/or disclose this information in order to implement and manage security and internal controls.

10 A condition of site access is that you must submit to a search of your personal belongings which may include bags, outer garments, and/or vehicles at the request of a Security. Searches will be conducted at Syncrude sites, and provided lodging locations.

Failure to comply with any of these SECURITY EXPECTATIONS may result in removal of your Syncrude Site Access privileges and will result in notification of your management.

What is acceptable government-issued ID?

All workers requesting a Syncrude ID badge must present one of the following pieces of valid Government-issued Photo ID to the ID Station Attendant:

- Driver's License
- Passport
- Permanent Resident Card
- Canadian Citizenship Card
- Federally Issued Status card
- Provincial ID Card including:
 - B.C. identification card or Services card (BCID)
 - Alberta Identification Card
 - Saskatchewan Identification Card
 - Manitoba Identification Card and Manitoba Enhanced Identification Card for non-drivers
- Ontario Photo Card

- New Brunswick Photo ID card
- Nova Scotia Identification Card
- Newfoundland and Labrador Photo Identification Card
- Prince Edward Island Voluntary ID
- Yukon General Identification Card
- Northwest Territories General Identification Card
- Nunavut General Identification Card
- Quebec does not Issue a photo card for non-drivers

NOTE: All Identification must be valid at the time of presentation and include a photo. Temporary Licenses and any other ID's not listed above will not be accepted Failure to provide this identification will result in no Site Access

Where do I get a Syncrude ID?

The ID station for the 2022 Project Mâmawi event will be in place at Athabasca Lodge, located in the Flight Centre area. Ask the Front Desk staff for directions.

Everyone working the Turnaround requires an RFID badge, how do I get one?

The 2022 Project Mâmawi Turnaround will be utilizing Syncrude Location Services to enhance the safety and productivity of its workforce throughout the duration of the event.

Individuals working for the event will be required to visit the badging station at Athabasca Lodge or the Safety & Productivity Operations Center (SPOC) in Building 2050 on Day 1 to obtain their RFID badges. Please have all safety tickets and identification with you BEFORE proceeding to the RFID/ID Station.

You must go to the Badging station even if you have an existing Syncrude ID badge.

TRANSPORTATION

Where are Athabasca and Beaver River Executive Lodge located?

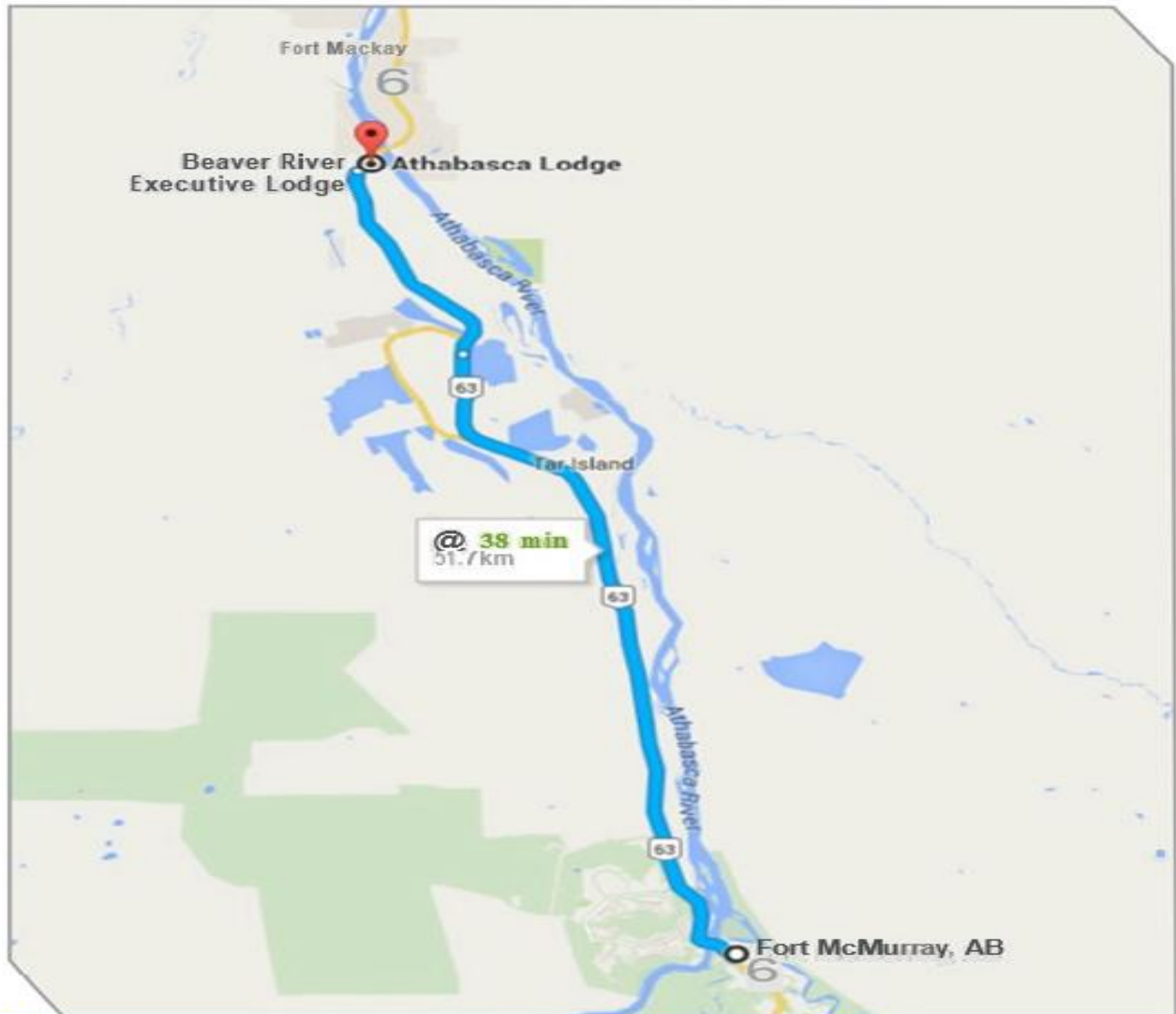
Athabasca and Beaver River Executive Lodge are located approximately 52km North of Fort McMurray, SE &E Hwy #63, West of Athabasca Road & East of the Ft. MacKay Turnoff.

What are my options for getting there?

Syncrude does not provide taxis, airline service or busing to/from Fort McMurray, Edmonton or Calgary. Please see next page for driving directions and map.

How do I get there driving from Fort McMurray?



- Take Highway 63 North for approximately 50 kms
- Turn right to head East at the Ft MacKay Turnoff
- Follow road and take first Left to head to Athabasca Lodge or first left to Beaver River Executive Lodge

Syncrude will provide uninterrupted transportation services from Athabasca and Beaver River camps to designated work locations at Syncrude Mildred Lake Site. Timing and schedules will be posted at the lodges.

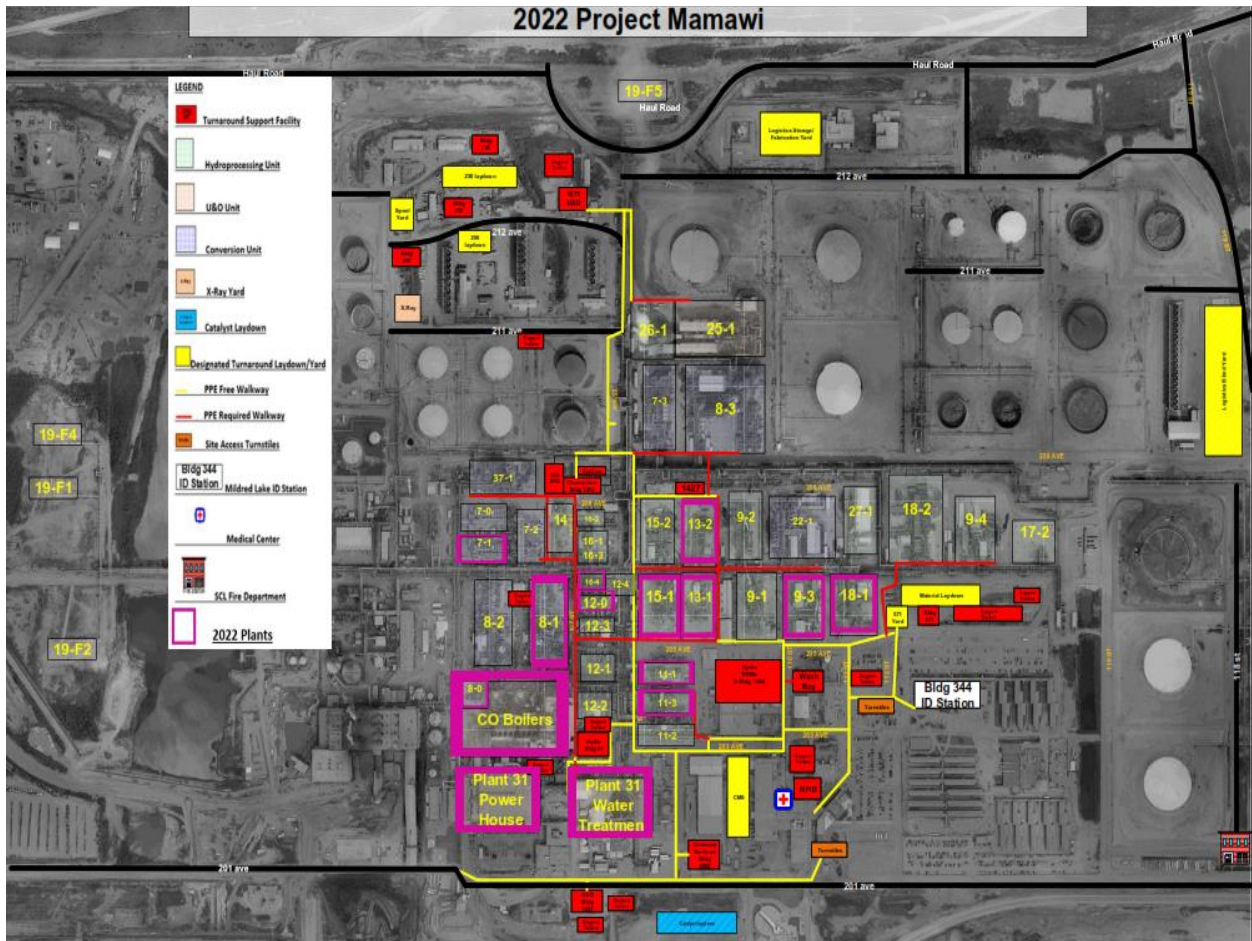
Athabasca and Beaver River turnstiles will be used to scan Syncrude ID cards prior to boarding buses. Make sure you visit the ID station in the camp beforehand if you need an ID.

Confirm your work location with your employer prior to boarding as buses only stop at one of the designated on-site locations.

When returning to camp you will be picked up at these same locations and will be required to scan your Syncrude ID when going through the turnstiles at Athabasca/ Beaver River.

There is limited parking on site for personal vehicles. Illegal parking and/ or non-compliance with parking signs may result in a Municipal Parking Ticket (\$120 00 fine).

Where do I get my Syncrude ID card?

- Syncrude ID cards will be issued at the Athabasca lodge. In the Flight Centre area.

What do I need on my first day?

Please Bring:

- Your Union Hall dispatch
- Your Packed Lunch
- Government-Issue Photo Identification.

Are meals provided?

Yes, the lodge has dining facilities available for you to enjoy. Remember to visit our bag-up room to pack your lunch for the day to bring with you. For times of service, please see civeo.com/syncrude and go to Lodge Information.

How do I get to my workplace?

There will be provided transportation from the lodge to your work area. Please check with your lodge for the updated busing schedule.

Do I need my PPE on the first day?

Your employer will inform you of PPE requirements for site.

How do I get back to my lodge?

There will be busing provided to get you back to your lodge. Updated busing schedules will be provided at the lodge.

I have a lodge-related concern. How do I get resolution?

For a more immediate resolution, complete a Lodge Comment Card or speak to the Front Desk Agent. Alternatively, you can reach out to your Job Steward who can bring up the issue during the weekly Camp Committee.

I have an issue with my reservation. What do I do?
